

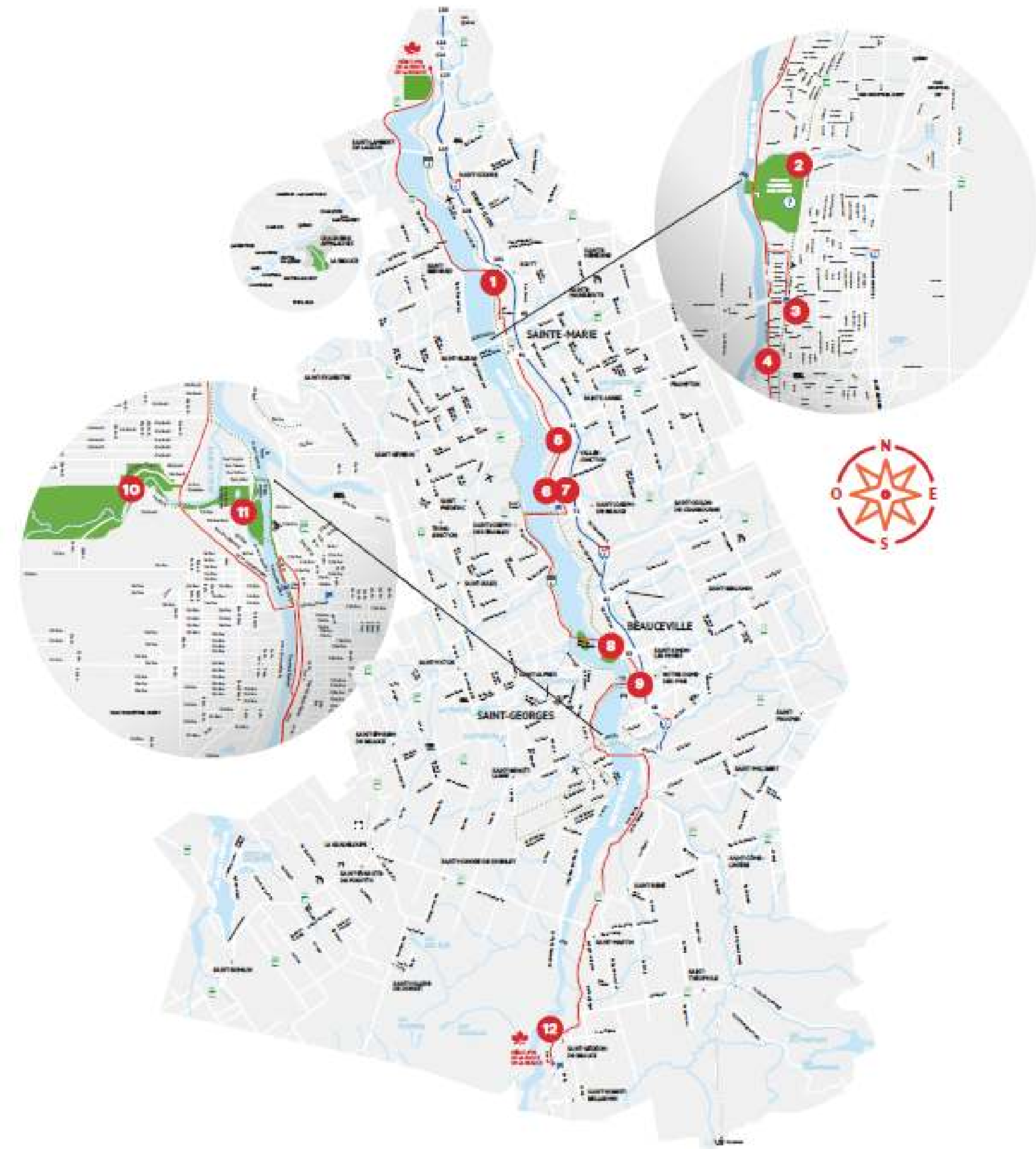

Whether for a quick stop or a complete visit, take the Route to immerse yourself in the Beauce area!



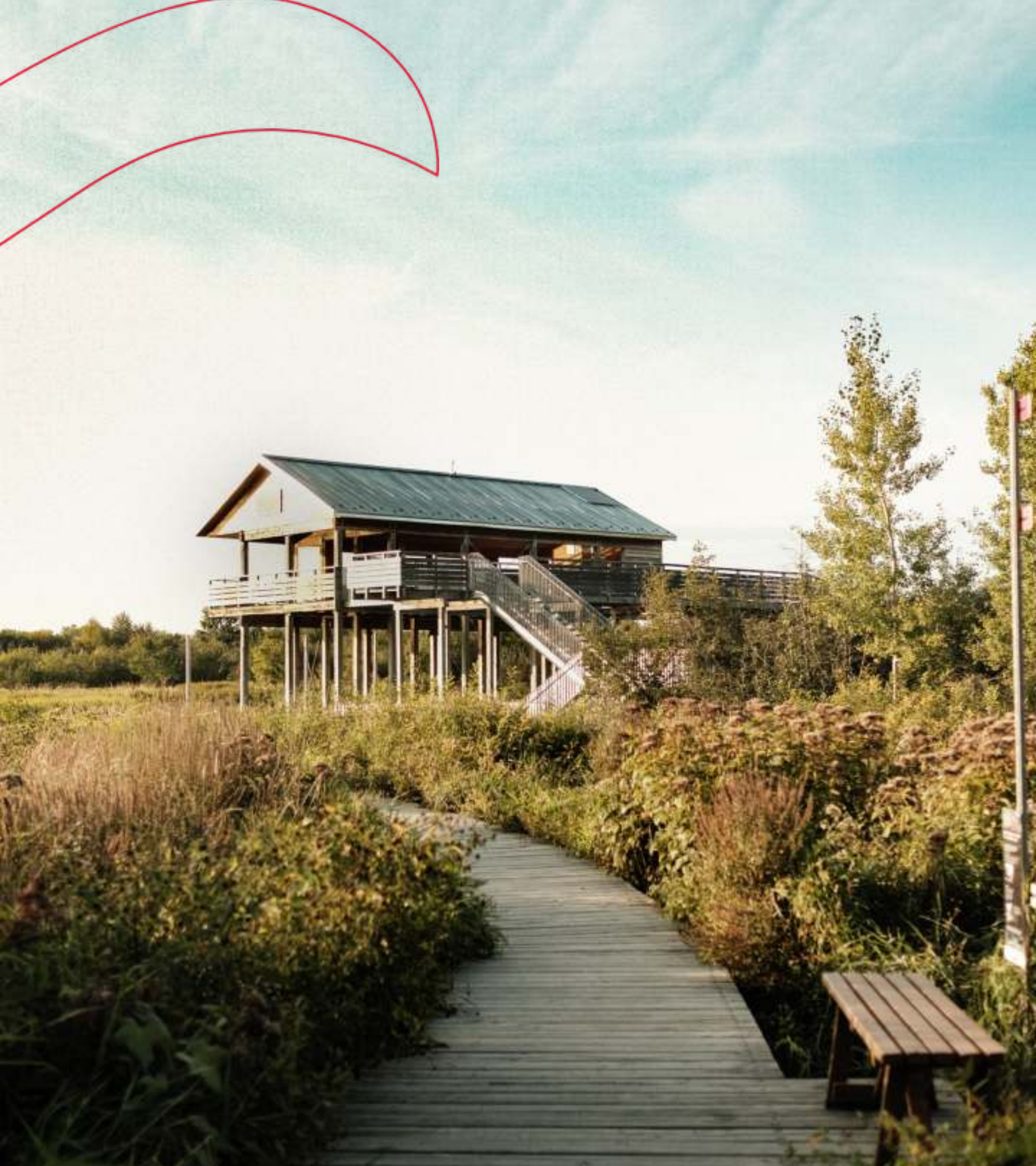
CYCLE ROUTE

DOMAINE TASCHEREAU - PARC NATURE

Sainte-Marie

The Central Park of Sainte-Marie!

In Beauce, we are truly unique! By visiting Sainte-Marie, you will just be amazed to find the most flooding park in Quebec in the middle of the city...

This eco-refuge is one of the 12 must-sees to discover on the Route de la Beauce. Go there to walk along its footbridges, observe several species of birds, picnic from the top of its pavilion with a splendid view of the marsh and discover the history of the flooding of the waters which whom we live with since hundreds of years. You will be impressed!



PARC DES RAPIDES DU DIABLE

Beauceville

A proximity to the river!

Go to the Parc des Rapides du Diable, one of the 12 places that hosts our Miracles on the Route de la Beauce. There, it is not the devil that you will encounter, but a great little corner of paradise for a stopover in the heart of nature.

As a couple or in a group, take out your picnic basket and settle down in front of the spectacle offered by the Chaudière River and the rapids crossed by large rocks. Walk in the forest and learn more about the history of this park by doing a bit of reading on the thematic panels.

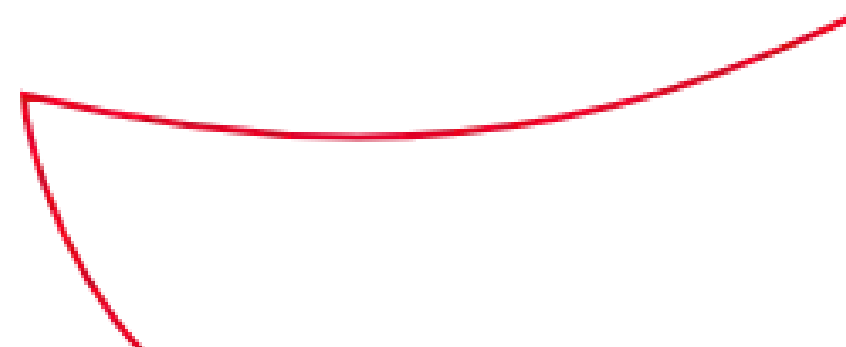
BLEUETIÈRE MARLAND
